During the workshop-rounds two workshops will be offered: a private and a public law workshop. Everyone can, in any order, attend both workshops. Upon registration you can indicate which workshop you would like to attend first (public or private law).

In the **private law workshop (Giesen and Lambooj)** a discussion will take place on claims for damages against multinationals, with special attention for the claim against Shell concerning oil pollution in Nigeria. What are the consequences in terms of the discussion on corporate social responsibility and the liability risk of these corporations?

In the **public law workshop (Goldschmidt)** a discussion will take place on the difficult position of international corporations when respecting human rights. Increasingly, international corporations are bound to human rights standards, while this may not correspond to their wishes or the profile of their client. The most important cases will be discussed.
